Updates from last term

Vegetarian pricing

Sexual Assault Policy Changes

Couple of issues with the current Policy on Bullying and Harassment

There's a bit of a discrepancy at the moment with external reports, as either college policy, the policy of the other college, or university policy could be employed. Additionally, external representation currently only guaranteed for the accused party under college policy. Carys says it would be useful to be in line with the university policy. Magdalene College Oxford's policy was pointed out as an example of a good policy.

Gym harassment signs

Priya suggests putting up signs in Castle Court gym about appropriate behaviour and harassment

Idea that it would make people feel more comfortable. Priya also to talk to SU Women's Officer to try to get these put in the uni gym too.

Flora also raised the point that a lot of people don't realise about the Castle Court gym's women and non-binary hours, or don't respect them. They're currently not very well sign-posted - it was suggested there could be an email and a social media post to highlight that they exist.

Period products updates

Priya raised idea of having period cup reimbursements

Agreed that the UCS could reimburse students for purchasing period cups, as there have been similar things offered in the past. It was felt that it would be better to reimburse students purchasing them rather than the UCS ordering & distributing them.

Priya also announced that there is a new company providing period products (who are more inclusive in their branding), and that they will be added to the buttery toilets soon.
